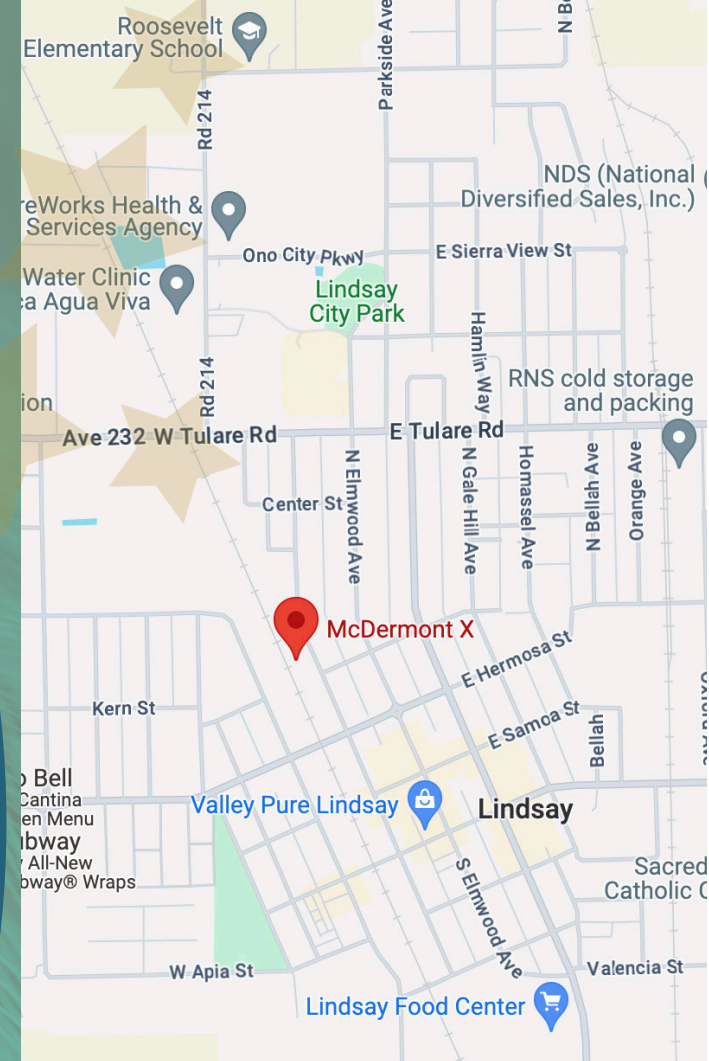

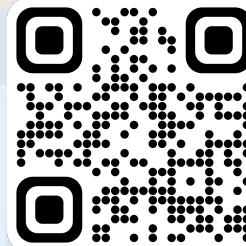

STRIVE DOGS FLYBALL SEMINAR

We are bringing back the CanAm / UFLI champion and Flyball World Record Holder, Rocket Relay's Aaron Robbins!

This is our 5th seminar event with Aaron in the Bay Area and we are seeing huge improvements in the training and thoughtful criteria driven foundations that he's instilled on past participants.

Aaron constantly updates his methods and foundations program and works with some amazing clubs and individuals; we have watched these teams compete with numerous records and amazing times hitting 14 seconds on the clock this past season from his training...

SEMINAR DETAILS / SCHEDULE

The Seminar will take place on Friday (03 May 2024). We will be running on competitive flyball mats with 80+ ft of run back.

For those holding Working Spots, Aaron will be working directly with each dog/handler team to help drive training and problem-solving skills. Each working spot will utilize the ring twice during the day to help solidify any techniques/training advice. Please note that your dog will be working directly with Aaron. You will need to bring any necessary equipment to ensure that the setup is familiar to your dog and that you are able to replicate it once you return to your club/team practices. If you need an additional dog in the other lane, make sure that you plan accordingly. Anyone additional team members will need to either hold a working spot or audit spot to participate in the ring.

For those holding Audit Spots, you are welcome to all lectures and conversations during the Seminar on Friday. Additionally, feel free to ask any questions to get the most of your time and take frequent notes for your use.

We ask that you respect the privacy of each Working Dog during the seminar and not take photos or videos of dogs that are not working as part of your club or team. This is to ensure that everyone is able to progress on their own time and because different dogs are going through different techniques and training, we do not want potential training techniques to be taken out of context from the holistic nature of each dog's training path.

If you want to take videos and photos, just make sure to clear it with the person currently working the dog.

Dogs will be sequenced based on the skill they are working on. This is so that participants can see the progressing of the flyball foundational program that Strive Dogs has developed.

The initial list of working order will be published prior to the start of the workshop.

Once all the working dogs have worked their initial session, we will re-prioritize the working order based on current progress.

**** Please make sure you potty your dogs and prepare for your spot while the dog before you is working. This will allow us to move quickly from one dog to the next and will ensure that we get everyone the maximum time allotted for each working dog.**
